*Staff has developed the FY2019-FY2022 TIP for approval. The TIP development process is being accelerated this year because TIP's adopted after May 27, 2018 need to be FAST Act compliant. This requires that every project in the TIP have a description of how the project advances the achievement of performance targets identified in the State Long-Range Transportation Plan and our own Metropolitan Transportation Plan. Since our Public Participation Procedures require a 45 day public comment period staff is bringing the TIP to TAC so that the Policy Board can take action prior to May 27. We have included all of the Category Two projects that were identified and adopted by the MPO, worked with TxDOT on Grouped Projects, and with BTD on the Transit Projects. **Action Required.** (See attachment.)*
- 4) Regional Bicycle and Pedestrian Long-Range Plan  
*The Active Transportation Advisory Panel (ATAP) has developed a regional bicycle and pedestrian plan map for adoption as part of the Metropolitan Transportation Plan update. The map was developed using recommendations from the City of Bryan and City of College Station Comprehensive Plans as a starting point. For long-distance bicycling routes, Strava data was used to develop a loop system within the County. The ATAP will address connectivity to the R.E.L.L.I.S. campus once more concrete information is available. Of particular concern are connections from the new campus to downtown Bryan, Blinn College and the main campus of Texas A&M. **Action Requested.** (See attachment.)*
